- 25/12 St. Meletius, Archbishop of Antioch the Great (+381). New Martyr Christos the Gardener in Constantinople (+1748).
- 26/13 **Small Compline & Second Stasis of the Akathist Hymn.** Holy Apostles & Martyrs Aquila & his co-laborer Priscilla, disciples of the Holy Apostle Paul. Righteous Father Martinian of Caesarea in Palestine (+ca. 422).
- 27/14 Righteous Father Auxentius of Bithynia (+472). St. Cyril, Equal to the Apostles & Enlightener of the Slavs (+869).
